Bloc-ti-cal is woven on a wooden base. Each block "switches"

places with the previous block making an

unusual design.

Tin Man Wren House

Size: 6" D x 6" H

Weaving Levels: Advanced Beginner Level

Hours: 4

This adorable and useful bird house is a nice birdhouse for wrens and finches. The birds even use the moss as part of their nest. Techniques include over/under weave and twining. The roof is attached with wire, so it can be removed and the house can be cleaned.

Size: 8" D x 7" H (handle not in measurement) Weaving Levels: Advanced Weaving Level

Hours: 8

The Wapalo has multiple techniques, such as a double bottom, twining, X's around the middle of the basket, and a wrapped handle.

Grandma's Flower Garden

Cost: \$57

Size: 14" W x 8" D x 9" H

Weaving Levels: Advanced Beginner

Hours: 6

Techniques for Grandma's Flower Garden include setting up a woven base, start/stop weaving, and an arrow weave. The arrow weave allows easy access to attach the cloth flowers onto the basket.

Sunday classes will start at 9am or 9:30am and we will break for lunch from noon-1pm. Classes will resume at 1pm. Choose one class.
